Uniform Policy

Introduction

The purpose of the St.Fintan's Ns uniform is to give a sense of identity and unity and to develop a pride in the school and its environs. It is important for parents to understand that children are expected to wear the uniforms at all times and their tracksuits when required. It is permissible for children to wear their school tracksuits as uniform if they do not have P.E.

Change of Uniform

Following requests from parents regarding changing aspects of the school uniform the Board of Management initiated a consultation process with members of the school community. As a result from September 2016 the uniform of St. Fintan's NS is as follows:

- Crested navy v-neck sweatshirt with red piping (New)
- Crested red aertex/polo shirt (No change)
- Navy trousers/ skirt (No change)
- Navy tights/socks (No change)
- Black or Navy shoes (No change)

On PE days the uniform will be:

- Crested navy sweatshirt with red piping (Same as uniform)
- Crested red aertex/polo shirt (No change)
- Crested Navy tracksuit bottom and/or shorts (New)
- Navy tights/socks (No change)
- Runners suitable for PE (No change)

Long hair must be tied back. Only stud earrings are permitted.

Only the uniform and tracksuits appropriate to St Fintan's are allowed in the school and this policy is strongly supported by the Board of Management. If a child is not wearing the appropriate uniform, it is expected that parents will furnish a note to explain the omission.
