## Good Morning All,

- Reminder: all 3<sup>rd</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> class pupils' boxes must be returned to the school by 2pm today. Boxes not returned cannot go directly to classes when school reopens on 18<sup>th</sup> March. Late boxes will be quarantined for a period in our school hall.
- A new requirements for parents / guardians is that you should complete the HSE's "Return to Educational Facility Parental Declaration Form" when your child is returning to school after any absence / school closure (except weekends). The Declaration Form is available to fill out in the Attendance Notes section on your Aladdin Connect homepage after 3pm on the day before your child is returning to school. Accordingly, parents of all returning pupils, infants 6th class, will need to complete this after 3pm next Wednesday 17th March. The form will be indicated with a red notification dot on your Aladdin Attendance Notes Tab.
- For returning 3<sup>rd</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> class pupils: all our safety systems as successfully used for term 1 are still in operation. The yard is supervised from 8.40am. Returning 3<sup>rd</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> class pupils should again line-up in the mornings (if onsite from 8.40am) in their marked class lines. Your child will not be considered "late" however, unless they arrive to school after 9am.
- Staggered home times will be the same as in term 1:

Junior Infants: 1.15pm
 Senior Infantses: 1.30pm
 1st & 2<sup>nd</sup> Classes: 2.10pm
 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Classes: 2.20pm
 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Classes: 2.30pm

- Although not required at primary school level, all pupils from infants 6<sup>th</sup> class can wear a mask / face covering in school if they wish and teachers will support this.
- The Department of Education asks that parents do not congregate at school gates or inside school grounds. Therefore, our parent "waiting-zones" are not in-use at this time. In the mornings if bringing your child to school, please just "drop and go" for everbody's safety.
