- COVID-19 Arrangements for 2021-2022: We have been informed in a recent communication from the Department of Education that "schools should continue to operate in line with their Covid-19 Response Plans" after the summer holidays.
   Therefore and unless otherwise instructed by the Department of Education, COVID-19 systems and procedures will remain the same upon reopening for the new school year.
- Despite having zero reported cases of COVID-19 amongst our pupils up to this point, the Board of Management are initiating a whole school health and safety review with an external agency, to build on our successes and to help us to prepare confidently for the new school year.
- Further to the above, the Board of Management are planning to install some additional railings and gates around the school grounds to improve safety onsite. In some cases, planning permission will be required for these enhancements. So, you may see planning signs referring to these proposed enhancements being displayed at the school during the summer period.

- A huge thank you to all parents who made a voluntary contribution to the school
  this past year: this funding initially allowed the school to buy 8 latest model
  interactive boards for classes at the end of term 1. Over the upcoming summer
  period, a further 8 new interactive boards will be installed in remaining classes so
  that come September, all St. Fintan's NS pupils will have a latest model interactive
  board in their classroom.
- Thanks to all parents for paying for and collecting their child's school books for next year. A big thank you of course to the parents who helped to sort and distribute the books from the school hall recently.
- If any child has any school rental or library books at home please now return these to the school.
- Each day next week is a non-uniform day. Next Monday is also Book Day in St. Fintan's NS: Pupils can dress up as a character from a favourite book for the day and bring the book to school too. Book Day, World Autism Day and Down Syndrome Day were all "officially" on earlier this year, in some cases during periods of school closure. Pupils are of course welcome to wear blue for Autism or to wear odd socks for Down Syndrome next Monday too. Also on Monday next, parents will be able to make a donation to the Irish Society for Autism and Down Sydrome Ireland, through Aladdin. All monies raised will be shared evenly between the two charities.
