- COVID-19 matters:
 - At our most recent Board of Management meeting, all COVID-19 safety systems and procedures were reviewed. It has been decided that in order to continue to do our best to keep everybody in the school community safe at this time, there will be no immediate changes to our COVID-19 school safety systems. We are continuing with class "pods" and "bubbles", tailored assembling arrangements in the mornings and staggered home times. All COVID-19 safety systems are subject to ongoing review, taking into account the latest Government guidance.

- School Uniform: The Board of Management reviewed the school's Uniform Policy at its most recent meeting and asks that all parents remind themselves of this policy in its latest form (see www.stfintansns.ie) Please ensure your child wears their school tracksuit and suitable runners on PE days. Long hair must at all times be tied back and pupils may only wear stud earrings, for safety reasons.
- Whilst of course we understand parents wishing to look after their children and ensure they are happy in the mornings, we respectfully ask that parents at all class levels do not loiter or congregate in the yard in the mornings. We have been asked to communicate this by the Department of Education and there really is no need as the yard is supervised in the mornings by staff, from 8.40am. If there is an urgent message you need to pass on, please do so by contacting reception. Reminder: No dogs are permitted in the school yard, nor should they be tied to school gates / railings requiring children to walk passed them when entering or exiting the school.
