

St Fintan's National School Uniform Policy

Introduction

The purpose of the St.Fintan's Ns uniform is to give a sense of identity and unity and to develop a pride in the school and its environs. It is important for parents to understand that children are expected to wear the school uniform or crested tracksuit at all times.

St Fintan's National School Uniform

The uniform of St. Fintan's NS is as follows:

- Crested navy V-neck sweatshirt with red piping
- Crested red aertex/polo shirt
- Navy trousers/ skirt
- Crested navy tracksuit bottoms or shorts
- Navy tights/socks
- Black or Navy shoes with uniform
- Runners with tracksuit

Children have the option to wear either the uniform or tracksuit every day. However, on P.E. days they must wear their school tracksuit and runners.

Long hair must be tied back. Only stud earrings are permitted. Make up is not permitted.

Plain navy leggings or uncrested tracksuit bottoms are not permitted. Novelty tights are not permitted.

Only the uniform and tracksuits appropriate to St Fintan's are allowed in the school and this policy is strongly supported by the Board of Management. If a child is not wearing the appropriate uniform, it is expected that parents will furnish a note to explain the omission.

This policy was ratified by the Board of Management on the 22nd October 2024. It will be reviewed on an ongoing basis .
