Also, a big thanks to our special education teachers who have shown great team-spirit in teaching full classes many days this past term, due to COVID-19 related circumstances entirely beyond anyone's control. For term 3, in spite of the ongoing teacher substitution crisis, we have secured additional supplementary staffing to give extra learning support daily.
- A big welcome to Elaine our new morning secretary. The school office is open daily from 8.30am 3.45pm daily with Elaine and Sandra running the show!
- Well done to all involved in supporting our Gaeilge theme for the month of March. We finished off this week with a visit from "Giggles" and Irish speaking clown, who performed a very interactive show in our hall for all classes "as Gaeilge". Bhí an spóirt again maith sibh go léir!
- Next week we will plant our giant "Pollinator Pizza": thanks to all parents who have sent in SuperValu pollinator cards. Our Green School Committee have been busy gathering these up for our chart. Next week we plan that the committee will distribute pollinator "seed bombs" to all pupils, to plant up our new "Pollinator Pizza". This will be a giant 10 meter diameter circle of pollinator plants to support our local pollinators and biodiversity. Hopefully they'll be in bloom before the summer. The "pizza" will be at the front of the school facing onto Carrickbrack Road (top left as you look at the school from the front gate). A special word of thanks to the volunteer school family who have been helping us prepare "the pizza"!
- Swimming lessons during the school day will restart for 5th classes after Easter. This is a curricular area (aquatics) in our Primary School Curriculum. More information will follow for 5th class parents later this week.
- Next week on Aladdin I will send parents an overview of after school activities that will start after the Easter holidays. We will be very pleased to see the return of these activities, after 2 long pandemic years!
